Our R.E. Day today with its focus on the Holy Trinity has provided some wonderful learning opportunities. **Reception** explained how they have looked at three different sides to themselves; **Year 1** made shamrocks and plaits; **Year 2** shared a film showing their trinity triangular prisms opening up when floating on water; and **Year 3** merged the three different parts of the Holy Trinity into one whole by creating their own spinners. **Year 4** looked at different parts of an apple: the peel, the flesh and the core and how they could relate this to our understanding of the Trinity. **Year 5 and 6** discussed the symbols in Rublev's icon and **Year 5** created their own versions in clay, whilst **Year 6** developed 3-way optical illusions. An amazing day with some very reflective thinking!

This term in collective worship we are looking at Friendship. This week our bible reading was from John 21: 1 - 14. After Half Term our Christian value will be Respect and our Bible reading will be from Acts 2: 1 - 21.
