House Points - The results are in...

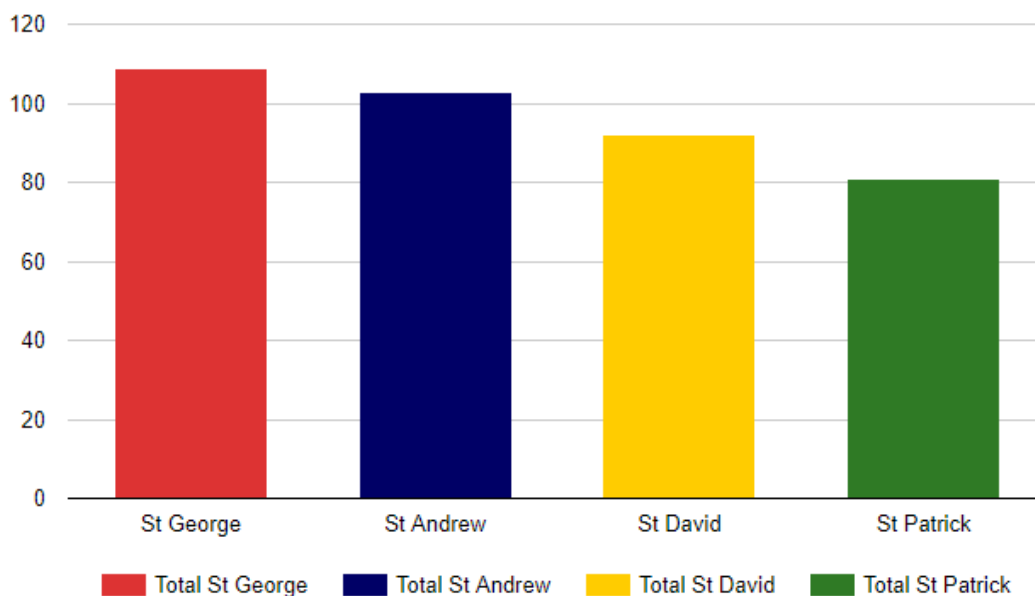
At All Saints, we actively seek to promote positive behaviour and this is clearly demonstrated in the excellent behaviour in school. One of the ways we look to praise children for their efforts and attitude is through our whole school House Points system.

These Houses are used in class to reward children on an individual basis but are also enhanced by the whole school House focus which is celebrated weekly in our Achievements Assembly.

At the end of each week, children from Year 6 check the total scores for each House in each class. From this, 4 points is awarded to the House in first place, 3 points for second, 2 for third, and one point for fourth. House Point totals are visible throughout the school year as coloured marbles are added to each House's jar in Achievements Assembly.

The end of year results are in: St George's - 109, St Andrew's - 103, St David's - 92 and St Patrick's 81.

If your child is in Reception, Class 1 or 2, on the last day of term their school meal choice will be what they would usually have on Friday, week 1 (unless you have already contact the school office to change your child's choice for this day).
